PCFB relies on a strategic, active, and community-focused Board to oversee management, advise the Executive Director and support the development of the organization.

We are seeking to recruit two volunteers to join our Board of Directors with any of the following areas of expertise:

- Fundraising: large gifts, donor relations, and/or corporate giving
- Finances: financials operations, planning, and/or accounting
- Human resources: recruitment, organizational planning, and/or performance management

Responsibilities

Individual Board members are responsible for the following duties:

- Attend monthly Thursday evening Board meetings (approximately 2 hours via Zoom at the moment).
- Commit to an additional 6-8 hours per month to prepare for meetings and participate on committees or work on board activities.
- Volunteer for 4-6 hours every quarter at the food bank.
- Keep informed about PCFB's foundational and financial documents
- Keep generally informed about ongoing activities at PCFB and act with honesty and good faith to support the best interests of PCFB

Term: Be available to serve a minimum of a 2-year term with eligibility for reappointment for successive terms.



HOW TO APPLY

To apply, please submit your resumé along with a 1-2 page letter or a 3-5 minute recorded audio or video message that addresses the following:

- Tell us a bit about yourself and what connects you to the issues that PCFB is working on.
- What is your current connection to PCFB (if any)?
- What is your understanding and commitment to improving food security and eliminating poverty?
- What is motivating you to join our Board?
- Tell us about your relevant experience and the skills you'll be able to contribute to PCFB.
